Reading green words with Set 3 sounds.

Set 3 sounds are sounds with two or more letters that go together and change their sound.

For example: <u>ea oi a-e i-e o-e u-e aw are ur er ow ai</u> <u>oa ew ire ear ure</u>

To help children to learn these special friends we teach them a little story linked to a picture.

Reading books: Children who can read these sounds in words will be able to read Blue and Grey Story Books (see e-books on Oxford Owl Guide for parents). https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/reading-schemes-oxford-levels/read-write-inc-phonics-guide/

In Set 3 children learn alternative special friends (2 or more letters that make one sound) which make the same sound as special friends learnt in Set 2 but are written differently (e.g. <u>ee</u> as in f<u>ee</u>t and <u>ea</u> as in b<u>ea</u>t).
