<p><b>Aims:</b> At St Matthew's we aim to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Through the light of faith, uphold the distinctive <b>Christian</b> ethos of our school whilst valuing our multi-faith community.</li> <li>Nurture the light within our children so they make good <b>choices</b>, take ownership of their learning and are proud of their achievements.</li> <li>Enable each other's light to shine by building relationships where children, parents and staff are valued and we all <b>learn together</b>.</li> <li>Empower our children so they recognise their light and <b>respect</b> the contribution that they and others make to the world.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Aims: Teaching French at St Matthew's we aim to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Equip children with the language to be able to have a conversation in French by the time they reach year 6 using 8 key phrases and questions</li> <li>Celebrate French learning and Francophone culture through song, conversation and a Whole School French celebrations (French inspired lunches, workshops)</li> <li>Encourage teacher input to ascertain what works well in their year groups and to develop what can/must be improved to benefit learning and extend the children's learning of French.</li> <li>Gain children's input: we want them to enjoy French so using school panels (like RE), School Council and student voice to ensure we have an appropriate and enjoyable French curriculum that inspires but also challenges the children, supporting them to make progress in French at St Matthew's</li> <li>Encourage children and teachers use the classroom languages resource to showcase their knowledge of the French language across all school experiences not explicitly to French lessons (i.e saying Très bien- very well to praise a child who has done well.)</li> <li>Promote language and celebrations through <a href="#">European Day of Languages</a> (global day of languages to reflect diversity and inclusion of all languages spoken by children attending St Matthew's) on 26<sup>th</sup> September</li> </ul>

<b>We will do this by:</b>	<p><b>We will do this by:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using the Scheme of learning, resources and teacher's knowledge to deliver engaging lessons</li> <li>• Using songs to engage and enthuse learners</li> <li>• Valuing and respecting cultures and lifestyles of French-speaking countries (not just France!)</li> <li>• Enable children to take ownership of their own learning</li> <li>• Use assessments to track and monitor learning and student progress</li> </ul> <p>Lesson format – French 30 minutes per week. Start of the lesson: Song to engage learners in content / theme for the lesson.</p> <p>Greetings recalled and reinforced each lesson</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bonjour - Hello,</li> <li>• Ça va? - how are you?</li> <li>• Quelle est la date aujourd'hui – What is today's date?</li> <li>• C'est xxx le xx Number xx (month)</li> <li>• Quel temps fait-il? What is the weather like?</li> <li>• Il fait / il y a ...- The weather is:</li> </ul> <p>Lesson content (18 mins) End with song (2 mins)</p> <p>Every lesson will not require evidence in books – speaking in the lesson is evidence so photos and short films on uploaded to SeeSaw or can be collected and uploaded to the French shared drive (year and class folders)</p>
