

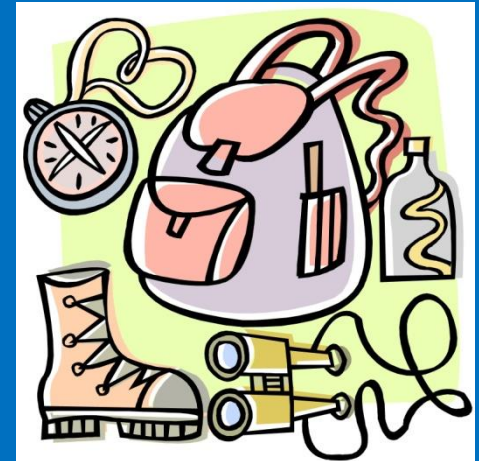
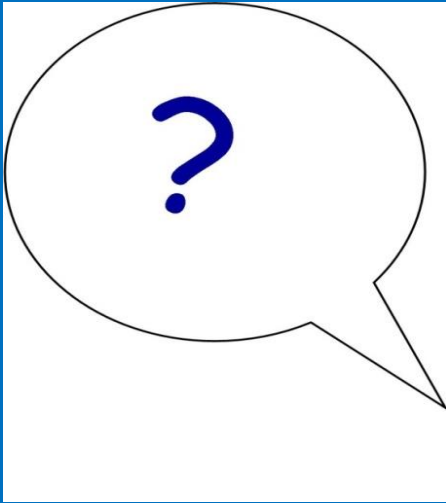
# Building Learning Power

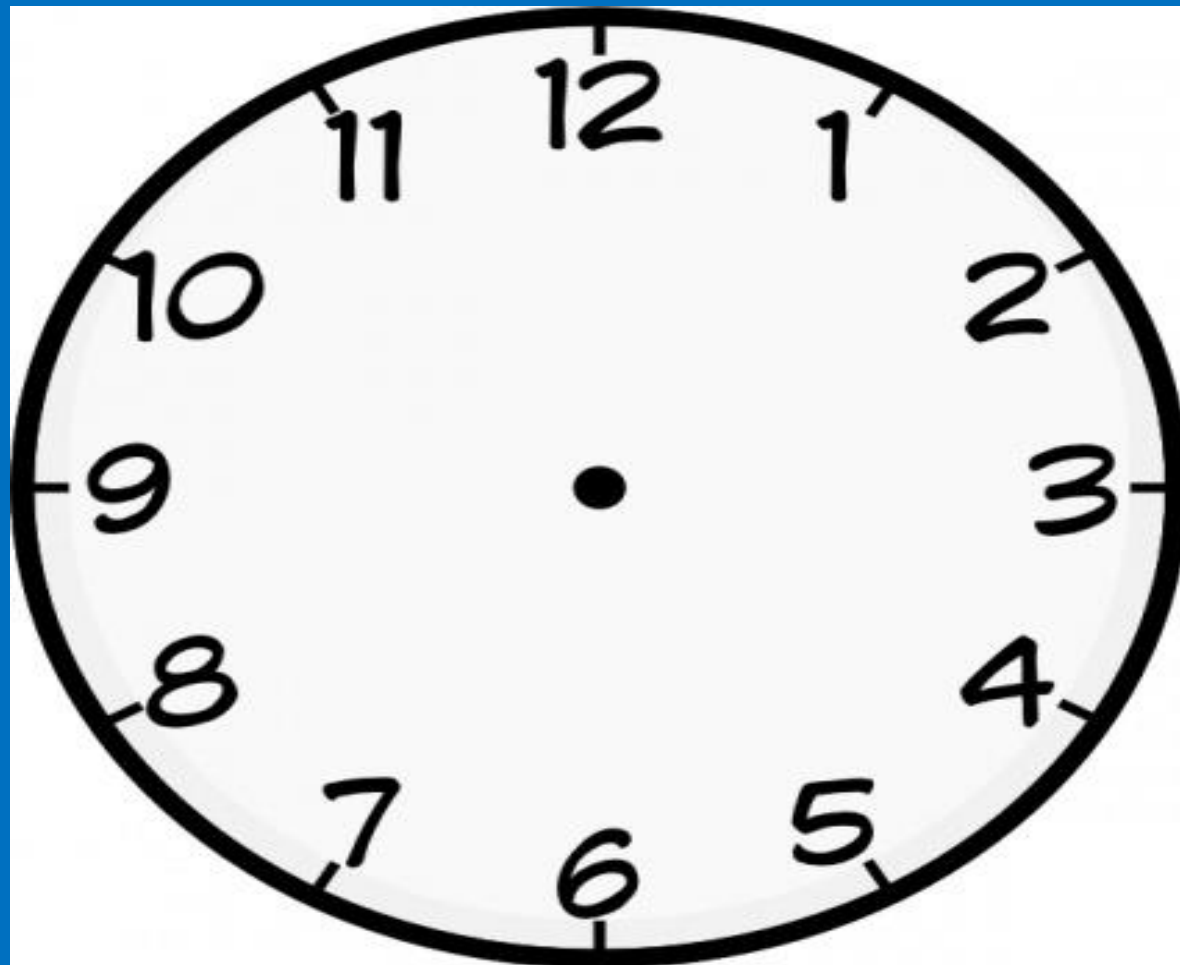
